


Introduction and ideas

Location: Albardastraat, Nijmegen

■ **Surface**: 220 m²

Objective: a more (diverse) location in the neighborhood for plants, insects, birds, hedgehogs and for the street to connect

Idea submitted to the neighborhood plan (wijkplan) – there is a budget feasible request? 2k€





Plans and prerequisites (but nothing is set in stone!)

- The three trees (maple) have to be integrated with the plan
- Place hedgehog hotels, insect hotels and bird houses (a neighbor is willing to build them – he can use tips and tricks)
- Layers in the vegetation: keep a semi-open system, so neighbors keep an overview of what is going on
- Plants and flowers: preferrably endemic, flowering from late winter to late autumn
- Maintenance: has to be doable, the neighbors have to do this
- We would like to have a visual sketch to present to the municipality
